4 1. Problem Definition & User Research
$\square$ Define your product vision and user goals
☐ Conduct stakeholder interviews
☐ Interview at least 5 target users
☐ Create user personas
$\square$ Map the customer journey
☐ Identify key user pain points
2. Ideation & UX Strategy
☐ Run ideation workshop with team
$\square$ Brainstorm feature ideas and group them by value
☐ Prioritize features (MoSCoW / Value vs Effort)
$\square$ Create a sitemap or navigation structure
☐ Draft a one-pager UX strategy brief
<b>1</b> 3. Wireframing & Content Mapping
☐ Sketch out key screens (homepage, onboarding, core features)
$\square$ Decide on messaging and page goals
$\square$ Build low-fidelity wireframes
$\square$ Map the required content per screen
$\square$ Review user flows for clarity and friction
4. Prototyping & Usability Testing
☐ Turn wireframes into a clickable prototype
☐ Prepare 3–5 real-world tasks to test
☐ Conduct usability testing (moderated or unmoderated)

$\Box$ Log usability issues and categorize them (Critical / Moderate / Nice-to-have) $\Box$ Refine the prototype based on feedback
🎨 5. UI Design & Developer Handoff
☐ Create moodboards or visual style references
$\square$ Design high-fidelity UI for all key screens
$\square$ Build a mini design system (typography, buttons, colors, spacing)
$\square$ Annotate interactions, spacing, and states for developers
$\hfill\square$ Use a handoff tool (like Figma Inspect or Zeplin) to deliver assets
6. Post-Launch UX & Iteration
☐ Set up analytics tracking (GA4, Mixpanel, Hotjar)
$\square$ Collect qualitative feedback (support tickets, user interviews)
☐ Conduct a mini UX audit 2–4 weeks post-launch
☐ Track KPIs like time on task, conversions, retention
$\square$ Plan your first round of UX/UI improvements
Assign owners for each phase if you're working with a small team
Track progress weekly using this checklist
